Cynthia Wilcox Lischick, Ph.D., L.P.C., D.V.S., is a cognitive developmental psychologist working in the area of mental health, domestic violence and child abuse for more than 20 years. She serves as a member of the Central Region Child Fatality and Near Fatality Review Board, and the NJ Task Force on Child Abuse & Neglect-Protection Subcommittee. Dr. Lischick holds a joint appointment at Rutgers-Newark Graduate School, Dept of Public Affairs & Administration and the UMDNJ, School of Public Health.

Eloise J. Berry-McBride, Ph.D. Eloise J. Berry-McBride, Ph.D. is a licensed psychologist in New Jersey. She has worked as a Mental Health Clinician for the CARES Institute at UMDNJ & as adjunct faculty in the Psychology Department at Camden County College.
