Learn the basic skills required to perform jobs as an Automotive Technician, Automotive Service Writer, and Automotive Parts Department Representative.

Course Description

- 1200 program hours covering all areas related to vehicle maintenance and repair. Participants will receive 31 industry recognized credentials pertaining to Steering and Suspension, Brakes, Electrical/Electrical Systems, Heating and Air Conditioning, and Hybrid maintenance. Participants will also be prepared for ASE certifications.
- The course includes a combination of theoretical concepts (classroom), hands-on training (shop), internship (experimental learning), and life skills/job readiness workshops.
