Reflecting Back On The Newark Rebellion



Monsignor William J. Monsignor Linder arrived in Newark in 1963 after he was assigned to Queen of Angels Parish. In the aftermath of the 1967 rebellion—also known as the Newark uprising—Monsignor Linder and a group of residents established New Community to address the needs of residents in areas such as housing and childcare.
